Choose your instrument

Find out which instruments are taught at your school. For our Star Classes for Year 3 upwards you can choose violin, cello, guitar or keyboard. For Year 4 upwards you can choose flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone, or one of our *Endangered* instruments, oboe, bassoon, French horn or double bass.

Instrument hire is available for all instruments except piano, keyboard, guitar, ukulele, saxophone, recorder and drums.

Choose your lesson

For lessons in school, during the school day, you can choose:

- Group Tuition: 3 pupils in 30 minutes, or 2 pupils in 20 minutes, or individual 10 minute lesson if no suitable group
- Paired Tuition: 2 pupils in 30 minutes or individual 15 minute lesson if no suitable pair
- Individual 20 minute lesson
- Longer individual lessons are available as pupils progress

For lessons at Croydon Music and Arts you can choose:

- Star Class: lessons in a larger class, 9.00 - 10.00 on Saturday mornings
- VoiceWorks Choir: 10.00 - 11.00 on Saturday mornings

There are 10 lessons each term. Star Classes and Group Tuition are recommended for primary school beginners. Pupils can attend a lesson in school and a Star Class at the same time. As well as having specialist tuition on their chosen instrument young musicians in Star Classes also have the opportunity to play in larger groups.

Making Progress

Once young musicians have achieved their first Croydon Music Star award they can join one of our **Star Workshops** (also 9.00 - 10.00 on Saturday morning). After achieving their third Croydon Music Star award young musicians can progress to more advanced ensembles and a Merit Award individual lesson.

After you have applied

When there is a space we shall contact you and send an invoice. If a Star Class is full we shall try to arrange a new class on another day. Once we have received payment the teacher will contact you to tell you the date and time of the first lesson. Another young musician's exciting journey can then begin!
