NB:

- PE Kit should be brought into school on a Monday in a small bag (ie draw string) and taken home on a Friday for washing. PE Kit needs to be in school ready for use all week!
- Earrings must be removed for all PE lessons, including swimming.
- Swimming kit must be brought to school in a small bag (i.e. draw string) on the morning of the swimming lesson and taken home at the end of the day.

Jewellery and Make Up



- Children may, if they wish, come to school wearing small stud earrings. Please note: no more than a single pair. Children are also permitted to wear a wrist watch. No other jewellery is permitted.
- Children are not permitted to wear nail varnish, make-up or any type of tattoos (including the stick on variety) to school.

Hairstyles



- Hair styles must be simple and straightforward; Extreme hair styles are not permitted (e.g. shaved-in designs, mohawks, shaved heads, extreme colour hair dyes etc).
- Long hair must be tied back for reasons of hygiene and safety.
- Hair bands, ribbons, bows or 'scrunchies', should be small, discreet, plain and either blue, black or burgundy. Hair bands should not have large flowers or ornaments attached to them.

Where can I buy School uniform?



- Our school uniform is designed to be simple and cheap to buy.
- All items within the school policy are either available order online through the School Trends website, via the school office, or can be purchased at other high street outlets, dependent on the item (please see the above uniform tables). If ordering via the School Trends website, they can deliver directly to your home.
