

Carrot Mark Making and Printing

Physical Development (grip), Writing (mark making), Expressive art and Design (Printing and painting), Communication and Language (talking about what they are creating, what the carrots feel like),

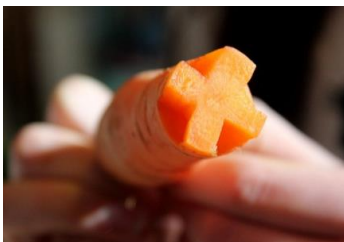
Try a different art and mark making activity using carrots and paint!



Set out some plates with orange and white paint (or any colour you may have). Dip your carrots into the paint and try some painting (it may help to cut the tip off). Can you draw a circle or straight lines? Can you write some letter sounds or your name?



Cut off the ends from a few of the carrots, and try some printing - you can create pages full of stamps, with lots of lovely paint texture.



You could cut out shapes from the sides of the carrots to make all sorts of different stamps.



Add in some white paint and stamp out bunny shapes. You could experiment with different colours to make chicks, Easter eggs or your favourite character from a book!
