Home Learning in the event of school closure

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to thank you for your support and understanding during this time of uncertainty. As it stands at the moment, the school is open and therefore children should attend school as normal. As of today (17th March), Public Health England guidance says that children should stay at home for 14 days if they or a person in their household has a persistent cough or fever, to avoid spreading infection to others. Otherwise they should attend school as normal. If and when the guidance changes we will let you know.

In the event of the school being closed due to the coronavirus outbreak, it is important that the children continue their learning at home. In order to facilitate this we will be providing learning activities and work for the children on our school website, **from the day of closure**.

You should select **School In Action** and then **Distance Learning**. Here you will see a folder for each year group. You will see specific details of work prepared by our teachers for your children and relevant links to learning activities. We will be updating this folder on a regular basis.



The children will be given a new exercise book for them to do this work in, therefore you should not have to print anything out at all. When a child completes a piece of work we would then ask you to photograph the work and email it to the teacher as an attachment, using the class email address. (Please see next page).
