Set 1 Speed Sounds at 9:30am and 12:30pm

Set 2 Speed Sounds at 10am and 1pm

Set 3 Speed Sounds at 10:30pm and 1:30pm

Whilst Set 1 was delivered during Reception, it is important to revise all sounds with a particular focus on Set 3 as these are trickier sounds. Help your child spot these sounds in their reading books so they become more familiar with them.

There is also a helpful guide for parents on how to teach phonics/reading here along with free ebooks


This includes an audio of how to pronounce sounds (for those of us that haven't a clue what sound 'x' makes!)
