

Year 2 Distance Learning

We have broken down the learning into 'lesson chunks'. In addition to the CPG books that have been sent home with the children, there are other activities available both on websites and on PDF's that can be done in the children's distance learning book. Please feel free to adapt the work as necessary to support your child.

Maths

We have uploaded links to videos to guide children through the arithmetic strategies and help you to support your child, along with website links to games for children to play. However, the focus should be on the arithmetic and reasoning books. Please encourage your child to follow the methods we teach to avoid confusion. The topics that have not yet been taught are time, money and weight and capacity. There is a document on the website explaining what should be cover in these units, so please feel free to teach this to your child. Although the other units have been taught, some may have been covered in the Autumn Term, therefore children may need support when revisiting these in their books.

Reading

All children have updated bug club passwords and have been assigned the correct book band colours, you will also find grammar, punctuation and spelling activities on this site. The children's user names and passwords have been stuck on the inside of their distance learning book. Please read with your child every day, asking questions to support comprehension. In addition to this, the children have been given their comprehension CGP book to work through.

Writing

To develop the children's writing, there are a series of lessons to work through each week. Some of these lessons use exciting stimuli from 'The Literacy Shed', please work your way through these lessons, focusing on the success criteria for each task. If children are finding their English difficult, please feel free to adapt this to support them. To support the children with their handwriting, there is an excellent website called writing repeater <https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/writingRepeater/>, this can be used on an ipad or tablet.

Spellings

New spelling will be uploaded weekly for you to practise and test your child on. Please as practise the common exception words alongside which have been uploaded in week 1.
