

Butterfly Matching and Sorting

Turn taking & following instructions: Personal, social and emotional development

Talking about the butterflies: Communication and Language

What you do:

Print two copies of the butterfly printables (next page) and cut them out.



Activities:

Together with your child, look at the different butterflies. Let your child choose their favourite butterfly and describe it to you.

Butterflies Matching and Sorting

Let your child search for the matching butterflies. They could sort the butterflies by shape or colour.

Butterfly Matching Game

Place the butterfly cards face down on the table. Taking turns, each player flips over two cards. If the butterflies match, the player can keep the cards and can try again. If the cards don't match, the cards get turned over again and the next player gets their turn. The player with the most pairs wins the game.
