

Cotton bud painted Easter Eggs



You will need some sturdy paper (like paper plates), paint (any colours but you must include white), some containers or tray (like an ice cube tray) to mix the paint, and cotton buds.



Draw egg shapes onto paper or card and cut out.



Next, pour some paint in your tray. Talk about the colours. Add white to each colour and get your child to mix the paint. What happened to the colour?



Start painting. Let your child explore how the cotton bud makes marks on their egg; experiment with dots, stripes and patterns.
