Wow! You are going to be an actor-retelling the story!

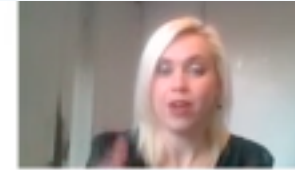

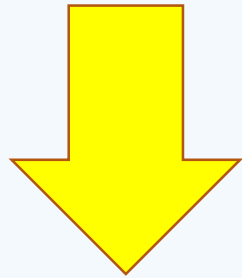
