

## Sound matching and word building – Jack and the Beanstalk

Take an egg box or a tray and place stickers on each hole/in an easy pattern. If you are feeling creative, wrap a beanstalk (something green like a scarf!!) around it. Write a letter on each sticker. Write letters on some magic gold beans (you can use counters, pieces of card, lego). You can cut white paper clouds to put under it to make it look like the castle in the sky.

Letter matching – eg Can you find M (say the phonics sound not the letter)



You can then start to blend sounds together ie say the word cat. Ask your child to identify the initial sound (c). Can they find the bean with the sound on it? What is next (a) and then (t). Put them together to form c – a – t. Practice saying it and then blending it together.

**To make magic gold beans, spray some kidney beans with gold paint... this is optional and not necessary!!**



