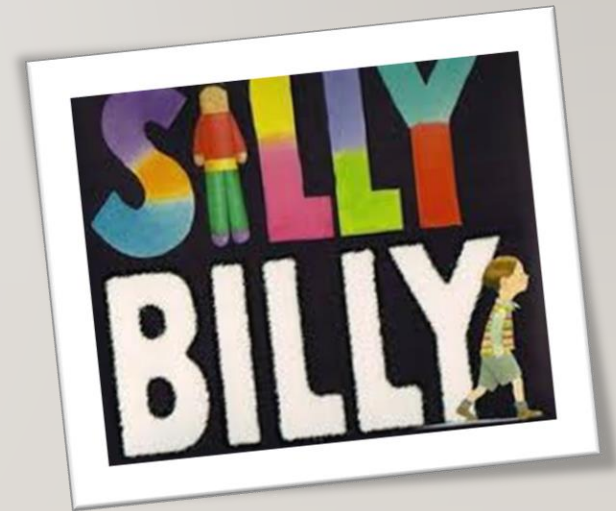

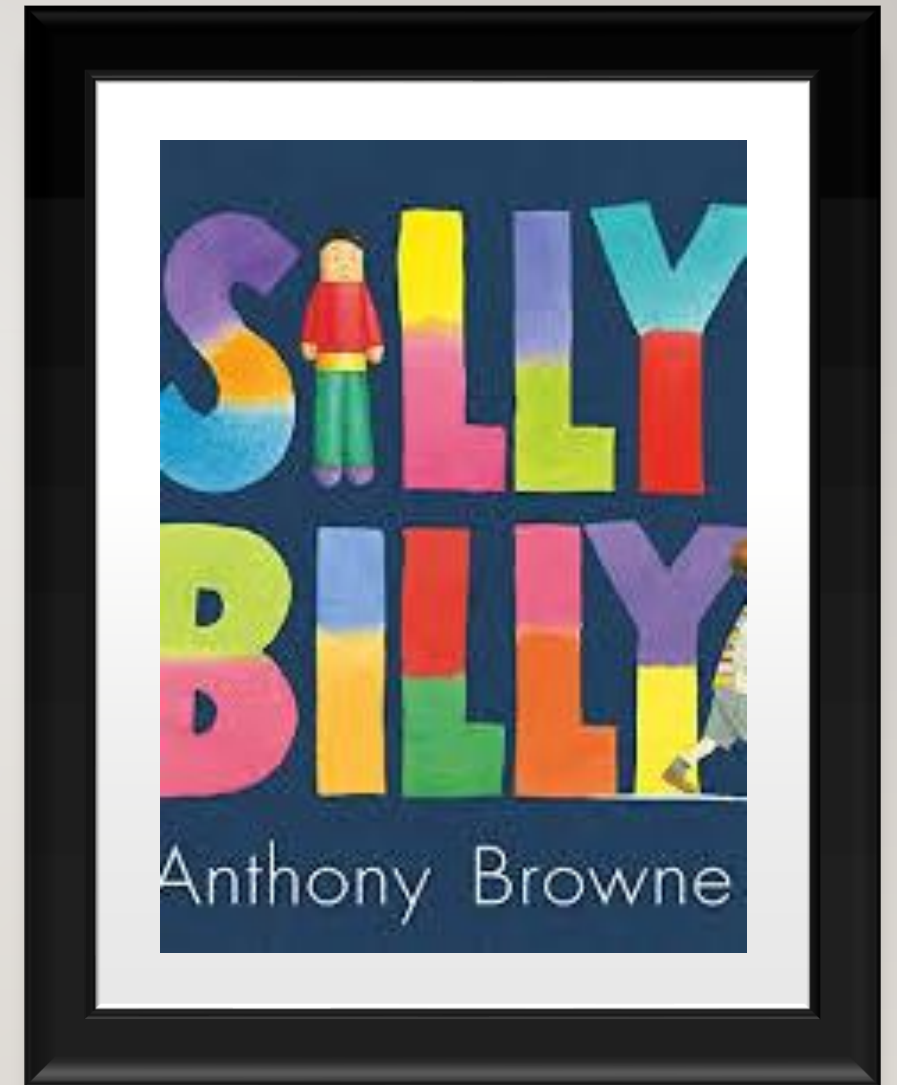
RULES AND EXPECTATIONS
