<p>15 hour funding available for low income families receiving</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Income Support • Universal Credit where net income is less than £15,400 pa • Tax Credits where net income is less than £16,190 pa • Please visit www.familyspacecroydon.co.uk if you think you may be eligible <p>Please note: If you are not eligible for funded hours, paid morning and afternoon sessions are available at £17.50 per session.</p>	<p>15 hour funding is available for <u>ALL</u> 3 and 4 year olds – automatic entitlement (no need to apply)</p> <p>30 Hour funding is available for working families who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Expect to earn at least £125 per week (equivalent of 16 hours at national minimum wage) • Earn less than £100,000 per year <p>Check for eligibility at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk If you are eligible, you will receive a code, which must be supplied to the nursery the term <u>BEFORE</u> you need it, along with the NI number used in application.</p> <p>The code must be renewed each term by re-entering details to the HMRC.</p> <p>Please note: funded hours are from 8:30-11:30 and 12:30-3:30. There is an additional lunch charge from 11:30-12:30. This is currently £7 which includes supervision for the hour and a hot meal is provided.</p>
