### History / Geography:

**Entry Point:** Animal 'safari'

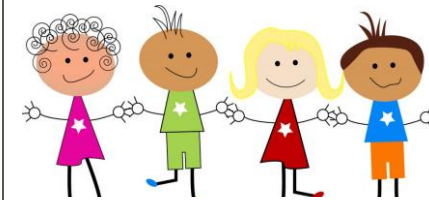
**Exit Point:** Animal Paw Print Art Day
