

Maths Links: place value up to 1000, addition and subtraction to 1000, rounding to the nearest ten, hundreds and thousands, all times tables facts up to 12x12. Use of hundred square on the playground for times tables games.

English links: Non-chronological reports, newspaper reports and a variety of fictional writing based around The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe.

Science: The children will be investigating different aspects of sound including: how sounds are made, how they travel, change and can be recorded.  
We will also be looking at different states of matter and classifying materials into solids, liquids or gasses.

## Terrible Tudors

Computing: In our computing lessons, the children will be learning the importance of staying safe online and using Scratch software. We will also make use of the new immersion suite!

PHSE / Values: The children will be exploring how to be a good citizen, their rights and responsibilities and democracy within our school. They will also be taking part in debates linking to our 'Votes for Schools assemblies.'

Wellbeing: The children will be exploring different ways to express their worries and thinking about how to be a good friend. We will be working on ways to boost our self-esteem and confidence.

Art: We will be looking at the artist Picasso and creating our own portraits. The focus will be on use of colour, composition and perspective. We will also be creating some large collaborative work for the gallery!

PE: Mr Thompson will be teaching a range of skills and techniques within a variety of disciplines.

Music: Mr Vinten will be teaching the children to read, write and perform their own musical composition.

MFL: We are very excited to be learning Spanish this year.  
Connecting Classrooms: The children will take part in a whole-school initiative called United against Waste. The children will explore how waste, in all its forms, impacts communities and nature both locally and globally. Throughout the year, pupils will participate in activities with their 1:1 Nepali school.

DT: The children will learn how to identify and understand: how a product is made, when it was made and how to evaluate it. They will also research chefs.

History / Geography: The children will be using atlases to locate the UK and Europe. They will be learning about the human and physical features of landscapes.  
In History, we will be exploring how the Tudors lived.
