

Hook for learning:

-Letters from the Lighthouse

End of topic finale: We will end the topic with a VE Day celebration. King George will visit and the children will eat WW2 celebration food and make traditional decorations.

English links: Our English lessons will link in with our Discovery topic. We will be looking at a variety of text types including instructions, non-chronological reports, diaries, newspapers and letters. Lots of our writing will be based around the book Letters from the Lighthouse.

Science:

Words along wires. We will look into how people communicated with devices using electrical circuits during WW2. We will create our own circuits to send messages and communicate information to our peers.
