


Maths Links: The children will be looking at fractions and learning all about equivalent fractions. The children will then use their knowledge of fractions to begin to understand decimals.

English links: The children will be looking at newspaper articles and they will be writing their own stories.

Science: The children will be understanding the water cycle and how it works. They will also be looking at different states of matter and classifying materials into solids, liquids or gasses.

## The wonderful Water Cycle



PHSE / Values: The children will be exploring how to be a good citizen, their rights and responsibilities and democracy within our school. They will also be taking part in debates linking to our 'Votes for Schools assemblies.'

Wellbeing: The children will be focussing on the transition from home learning to being back in school.

Geography: The children will be researching and identifying various solutions to global warming and their impacts in both the short and long-term on society and the environment. We will be developing our understanding of the water cycle and using geographical language to name the various stages of this.

PE: Mr Thompson will be teaching a range of skills and techniques within a variety of disciplines.

Music: Mr Vinten will be continuing to look at African drumming as the children appeared to thoroughly enjoy this.

MFL: The children will be continuing to learn about different fruits and vegetables and also the different body parts, in Spanish.

The children will continue to take part in a whole-school initiative called Connecting Classrooms. Throughout the year, pupils will participate in a variety of activities working closely with a school in Nepal.

Computing: In our computing lessons, the children will be learning the importance of staying safe online and using Scratch software. We will also make use of the immersion suite!

Art: We will be predicting colour mixing results with increasing accuracy and matching colours to colour charts. The children will be using colours for purpose and experimenting with creating mood with colour.

RE: They will be looking at the Easter story and understanding why it is important not to judge other people.
