

Maths:

We will continue with our work on addition and using a part, part, whole model. After that we will move on to subtraction whilst using cubes and counters to help. Leading up to Christmas, we will begin looking at shape.

English:

In English this term, the children will continue to explore a range of writing styles. This will include writing their own instructions on how to extract a fossil, a recount of a familiar story and festive poetry writing leading up to Christmas.

Science:

In science we will continue to look at the human body, discovering which parts of the human body do different things.

History:

In History, Year 1 will be learning about Amelia Earhart and Mary Anning. We will cover what they did and why they are such important people from history. We will use this information to begin sequencing important events from the past in order of when they happened. We will also be comparing old and new things and describing the difference between things in the past and modern day.

Geography:

In Geography, Year 1 will be introduced to the different ways we can find out information about the world (e.g. books, museums, atlases and photographs).

Computing: In computing this term, the children will be learning about online safety and learning how to log in and out of a device.
