Maths:

The children will be starting the term developing their understanding about addition and subtraction learning about number facts to 20 and to 100 as well as adding two-digit numbers through practical and outdoor activities. We will be learning about subtracting on a number line using our place value knowledge to help us.

English:

During our English lessons, we will be continuing to understand and apply our knowledge and skills of sentence structure within our writing. We will be retelling stories linking to our topic, 'Art Attack', linking to the skills we have learnt to sequence, plan and edit to make our writing interesting.

Science:

In science lessons we will continue to learn about the suitability of a variety of everyday materials and find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials and how they can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

DT:

Throughout the DT curriculum, we will be working towards the Winter Bazaar, planning and creating a product to sell. We will be thinking about what the product will be used for and how it will work, what materials we will need and its purpose, making templates to see what works best. We will use our maths skills to measure with accuracy and work together to construct and evaluate.

Geography:

In the children's geography lessons, linking to computing, they will be zooming in and out on a map and will begin to highlight and annotate digital maps together. We will start to explore the purpose of different image types and ask and discuss what they have seen, heard or read.



Computing:

The children will be encouraged to develop their geography skills through the use of technology. They will be doing this on a chrome book, iPads and in the Digiverse.

RE:

The children will be learning and exploring a number of topics such as, Diwali, Hanukkah, the Christingle and Christmas.

Wellbeing Curriculum:

As part of our well-being curriculum, the children will be participating 'Celebrating Difference Week', discussing what makes us and our families special and different and looking at where we belong.

MFL:

During this term, the children will continue to develop their Spanish vocabulary. The topic will be called, Nouns, Rhymes and Christmas.

Music:

The children will be focussing on their performing, composing and appraising their music.

PE:

Throughout this term, the children will be developing their skills in gymnastics.
