Maths links:

Children will start multiplication and division. We will start with multiplying and dividing 1,2- and 3-digit numbers by multiples of 10s and 100s. Children will look at different techniques such as column multiplication / division and using arrays. We will then move on to multiplying by 2, 5 and 10 to help consolidate our knowledge of these times tables.

English links:

As part of Black History Month, the children have been looking at the book "Little Leaders, bold women in Black History" and have written biographies based on a famous bold woman. Later on in the term, the children will be writing newspaper reports based on Boudicca, which we have been studying in our history lessons. The children will then move on to look at poetry and in particular, "Twas the Night Before Christmas". story.

PE: Gymnastics:

- Children will be improving different types of movement.
- Planning and performing a sequence of different actions

We will also be doing weekly invasion games when the children will concentrate on ball skills. This will lead up to team games, which will include dribbling, passing and receiving the ball.



PHSE / Values:

Children will be looking at celebrating differences and friendships.

MFL / International:

In Spanish this term, we are focussing on the calendar and celebrations.

History:

In this topic, children will have the opportunity to look at the history of Chipstead and Coulsdon.

Key objectives include:

- To order and sequence several events within the area
- Use evidence to describe the culture, leisure and way of life.
- Use evidence describe historical buildings and their uses.

Computing:

Children will begin to understand surveys and will create their own purposeful survey.

Art - Colour: We will be looking at textures and patterns linking with our Roman topic. We will consider the historical and cultural importance of pattern and create a mural.

Music: This term, children will be having weekly lessons with Mr Vinten., looking at a range of songs, old and new. They will also begin practising for the Christmas concert. The music assemblies will continue on Wednesday mornings.
