In maths this half term, we will cover the following objectives:

- Calculation (addition and subtraction)
- Measurement (length and perimeter)
- Calculation (multiplication and division)
- Times tables, using times table rock stars.

**English:**

This term, we will be working on the following;

- We will be working on recounts and persuasive letters based on the Tudor musician John Blanke.
- We will be looking at poetry from the book 'Jabberwocky', written by Lewis Carroll.
- We will also be looking at instruction writing.

**Science:**

During science this term, we will be looking at the human body, sound and electricity.

- We will basic functions of the digestive system
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions
- We will also be looking at electrical circuits
- Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with vibrating.
