

Maths:

In maths, we will begin to look at place value of numbers up to 20, introducing them to 2-digit numbers and what each number means. Using this information, we will add and subtract numbers up to 20.

English:

In English this term, the children will continue to look at different styles of writing. They will write a recount of a typical day in their life. We will then look again at retelling a familiar story using actions to help us. Finally, we will look at letter writing.

Science:

In science the children will begin thinking about the seasons and weather changes throughout the year and being able to recognise how and why the weather changes with the seasons.

History:

In history, we will be comparing things from the past to things today with reference to Brighton. What did Brighton look like? What did people do? Why has it changed?

Geography:

In Geography we will largely focus on the UK, touching on what it looks like, the countries and cities in the UK, the seas that surround it and reading maps to identify where we are. We will then focus on Brighton and the characteristics of that location.

Computing: In computing this term, the children will be learning about online safety and learning how to log in and out of a device.

RE: In RE this term, we will be beginning to look at Authority and Worship for different religions, starting with Christianity.
