Maths links:

Children will continue to develop their mathematical skills with the focus being on these topics:

-Multiplication, Division, Money and Statistics

Science: We will be starting to look at plants, with a focus on these 'big' learning questions:

What are the different ways that seeds disperse?

What colour flowers do pollinating insects prefer?

How do growing conditions affect seed germination?

What happens to celery when it is left in a glass of coloured water?

Can you identify all the parts of a flowering plant?

Geography:

This theme will cover areas including earthquake, mountains and volcanoes.

- Describe and show an understanding of earthquakes linking to the key places studied
- Understand and label the different parts of a volcano.
- Recognise the different types of volcanoes.
- Explain and describe the different states of volcanoes.
- Describe and understand the layers of a volcano and the causes of eruption.

English links:

This half term, we will be looking at the text Escape from Pompeii. Linking to our topic, the children will be learning about Pompeii and Mount Vesuvius. They will re-enact the story and will then retell the story with a historical setting.
