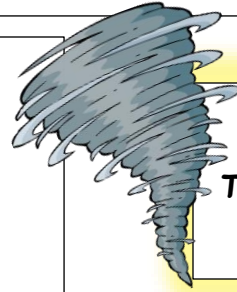


**Maths:**
