

Maths:

In maths, we will begin to look at place value of numbers up to 20, then introducing to 2-digit numbers and what each number means. Using this information, we will add and subtract numbers up to 20.

English:

In English this term the children will be retelling the story of Jack and the Beanstalk using actions to help. We will also be creating an explanation text where the children will write what the best conditions are to grow a seed. We will finish with writing poetry based on spring and Easter.

Science:

All of our science lessons this half term will be based on plants, the features of a plant and what plants need to grow. We will also learn the names of a variety of plants and trees and even plant our own vegetables! We will be conducting a couple of science experiments on what conditions a seed needs to grow.

Another experiment will involve us using food colouring in water to visually see how water travels through the different parts of a flower and where it ends up.

After this we will begin to learn where our food comes from and what a healthy balanced diet looks like.

Geography:

In Geography we will continue to study the seasons and the weather across the world and decide which countries can grow different plants and why.

YEAR 1 GROWING TOGETHER

**Art/DT:**

Linking to what we have learnt about in science about food and where it comes from, the children will begin to learn about preparing simple dishes safely and hygienically without using a heat source. The children will learn about the different techniques you can use to prepare a dish such as cutting, peeling, grating, rolling out and mixing. This will all lead up to the children designing and making their own fruit skewers towards the end of term.

Music:

The children will continue to work with Mr Vinten in their music lessons this year.

Wellbeing Curriculum:

In our wellbeing lessons we will be looking at how we have grown. Since the start of year 1, how have the children grown both in and out of school.

MFL:

The children will continue to learn Spanish this term and will move on to days and months as well as learning to say when our birthday is.

PE:

The children will learn and take part in more invasion games, again with a focus on netball and the skills associated with the game.

Computing:

In computing this term, the children will begin looking at coding and pathways.
