

Maths:

The children will be looking at measurement and will learn about mass and be using scales to compare different objects. The children will be practicing reading them accurately focusing on grams and kilograms. They will then look at length and height and use rulers and metre sticks to explore different objects around the school using centimetres and metres. We will then move onto temperature, volume and capacity.

English:

During our English lessons, the children will be researching all about the Queen linking their writing to the Jubilee celebrations. We will be writing a non-chronological report using the interesting facts that we find out from the chrome books and Digiverse. We will also be doing a character description of the Queen, using a range of interesting and exciting vocabulary.

History:

The children will be looking at famous explorers linked to our topic 'Land Ahoy!' and their discovery of different parts of the world. We will be researching these explorers and finding out what was discovered and the impact on our culture.

Year 2 – Summer 1**Land Ahoy!****Wellbeing Curriculum:**

As part of our well-being curriculum, we will explore the following questions: What does being 'healthy' mean? What can I do to keep myself healthy? How can I manage my feelings?

Computing:

The children will be using chrome books and going into the Digiverse to learn and record facts all about the Queen to support their English writing. As part of Geography, the children will be using the Digiverse to explore the world around them and looking at the physical and human features in the local area and globally.

Music:

The children will be learning and rehearsing songs in preparation for the Year 2 production with Mr Vinten.

Geography:

In Geography, the children will be using and constructing basic symbols in a key and using simple grid references to locate squares on a map. They will also be describing some of the human and physical features associated with an island.

Spanish:

In Spanish, we will be listening and learning a range of songs helping us to practice and recall counting to ten, colours, the days of the weeks and months of the year.

RE:

This half term, the children will be learning about the faith Christianity and their lifestyles and beliefs.
