Maths: The children will be completing their unit on decimals, where they will be looking at comparing, ordering and rounding decimals. After this, they will look at money and time!

Spelling Shed: We have enjoyed using Spelling Shed in school with the children and would encourage them to access their spelling lists and play the games at home!

Art: We will continue to refine our art techniques this term, including drawing and sculpture. The children have enjoyed using their sketch books to record observations and we will continue to add to them this half term!

Computing: Over this half term, the children will be enhancing their skills on scratch and building up to creating their own game. They will also be considering self-image and identity online.

Music: The children will be continuing to develop their keyboard knowledge.

The Well-being curriculum: This half term, the children will be focusing on the importance of being healthy. They will look at the benefits of a healthy diet, how regular exercise can benefit our bodies and our emotions as well as the importance of dental hygiene.

English: This half term, children will be learning how to write persuasive texts and will be writing a persuasive letter linked to the environment. We will also be learning about non-chronological reports as well as myths and legends! We will continue to learn about different grammatical features, including apostrophes, adverbials and subordinate clauses.

Science: The children will be learning about states of matter this half term. They will learn that materials are solids, liquids or gases. During this unit of work, the children will have the opportunity to observe materials changing state through an experiment. They will also explore the concept of condensation and evaporation.

PE: The children will be working on developing their athletic skills!

Geography: The children will kick-start our 'Eco Heroes' topic within Geography. They will be asking questions and researching what affects our climate whilst drawing on their previous knowledge on climate zones. They will then be looking at the consequences of global warming for the future and researching solutions and how this affects society as well as the earth both long and short term.
