

**Maths:** The children will be continuing their money topic before moving on to time, shape and statistics. Throughout June, children will complete their Multiplication Check. We are looking forward to carrying out maths investigations in the summer term!

**The Well-being curriculum:** The children will be looking at managing emotions in different social situations. They will also be looking at how to access advice and support to help manage their own or others' feelings. After this, the children will explore money, looking at it's role and how it impacts our daily and wider lives. Towards the end of the year, the children will look at how their bodies change as they grow up.

**Art:** We will be using recycled, natural and man-made materials to create sculptures.



**English:** This half term, children will be learning how to write instructions linked to a science experiment. We will also be exploring different poems and creating our own. In our final weeks, we will be writing our own adventure stories, demonstrating all the grammatical features we have covered this year!

**Computing:** Over this half term, the children will be enhancing their skills on scratch. We will be creating our own algorithms, building up to creating our own game and evaluating it.

**Science:** The children will be continuing to learn about states of matter this half term. They will learn that materials are solids, liquids or gases. We will also be learning about sound and finding patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.

**Music:** The children will be continuing to develop their keyboard knowledge. We are also looking forward to the return of singing assemblies in person led by Mr Vinten!

Further to this, they will try to understand the consequences of global warming and establish various solutions (eg. using renewable energy) to improve our future.
