Maths:

This half term we will be continuing to develop our understanding of Algebra and Ratio. The children will be applying their knowledge to problems and investigations. We will also look at transitioning to secondary school and recapping knowledge and skills required for a successful transition.

English links: the children will be developing their writing skills by using dialogue for characterisation. They will create their own 'Tree God' outdoors using clay and will use this as the inspiration for continuing a story. We will also look at persuasive writing in the form of adverts and brochures.

Science:

We will be looking at evolution and adaptation. The children will begin by looking at how animals are adapted to their environments. Following this, we will research Darwin's Theory of Evolution and discuss his findings. The children will present these on a 'E-Book' using the chrome books.

Art: The children will look at Pablo Picasso. We will study his works and describe common features and style. After this, the children will create their own 2D or 3D portrait in the style of Picasso using acrylic paint.

Music: Mr Vinten will focus on the music and songs for the production 'Pirates of the Curry Bean'

Year 6

Topic: Sparking Society



Computing: We will be using the chrome books to present research and findings about Darwin's Theory of Evolution.

Micro-Society: The children have begun to create their own societies based on a set of agreed values. They will elect leaders and assign job roles. Following this, the children will create laws and currency and begin to set up their own businesses. The society will then be ready to begin trading!
