

Maths:

This half term we will be:

- Exploring number names within songs and rhymes and using these in play,
- Beginning to say numbers in order / put numbers 0-10 in order,
- Beginning to count up to 10 using our fingers,
- Count items, saying 1 name for each item (1-5, 5-10)
- Subitise 1-3, 1-5 or 5-10 without counting,
- Explore one more and one less through practical problems.

English:

We will be exploring books that include different families, schools and homes. These will include 'So Much', 'Harry and his Bucketful of Dinosaurs go to School' 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' and 'The Paper Dolls'. We will learn about the characters and settings and begin to retell stories we are familiar with. We will talk about what is similar and different between our families and those in books.

In addition, we will continue working on our phonics, including learning new sounds, recapping old sounds and learning our red words. Throughout every day we will develop our skills for writing through fine motor activities such as threading and using tools for writing to mark make and write in our play.

Science:

We will be learning about the growth of humans by looking at babies, children and the elderly.

We will be learning and using the names for different parts of the body.

History:

This half term we will be exploring the significant events in our own histories. We will learn what past, future and present mean and explore this by looking at photos of us, and our teachers, now and when we were babies.

Geography:

We will be exploring our immediate environment at school. We will learn about the different places in our school and the names of these spaces. We will begin to request places we'd like to visit and some of us will create maps of the school.

We will be learning to take photos and videos of ourselves and peers with an adult.

We will be learning to use the Interactive White Board and will use this to support our learning of different subjects.

RE:

We will think about what a friend is. We will name our friends and begin to learn which qualities a 'good friend' has.

Art/DT: We will be beginning to learn what a 'self portrait' is and will be looking at our facial features using mirrors. We will then try to draw these features as part of our 'All About Me' topic. We will look at famous artists including Van Gogh and Matisse and the different ways they represent faces in

MFL:

In Spanish this term we are learning to say 'Hello' in Spanish.

Music:

In music this half term we will be learning the words and actions to new songs. We will learn about tempo and will try to sing these songs 'fast' and 'slow'.

PE: In PE we will be learning how to move our bodies in different ways, under, over and through different obstacles.
