

Maths:

In Maths, we will be looking at Place Value where the children will be looking at understanding numbers to ten, counting forwards and backwards within ten and looking at one more or one less than a given number. We will then move onto addition and subtraction within ten.

Science:

In science, we will be identifying and naming the basic parts of the human body and labelling them on a diagram.

We will also be thinking about the different senses and say which parts of the human body are associated with which sense.

History:

In History, Year 1 will be able to put different events of their life in order. They will also describe key memories and things that have happened to themselves and other people in the past and recognise the difference between past and present in their own and others' lives.

English:

In English this term, the children will start off by looking at the book 'The Secret Sky Garden' where the children will think about their own special places and describing them. We will then be moving on to look at letter writing where the children will get to write letters and then post them to their address.

Art/DT:

In art, we will be drawing self-portraits using different art mediums.
