

Maths:

In Maths, we will be looking at Place Value where the children will be looking at understanding numbers to ten, counting forwards and backwards within ten and looking at one more or one less than a given number. We will then move onto addition and subtraction within ten.

Science:

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In science, we will be identifying and naming the basic parts of the human body and labelling them on a diagram.

We will also be thinking about the different senses and say which parts of the human body are associated with which sense.

History:

In History, Year 1 will be able to put different events of their life in order. They will also describe key memories and things that have happened to themselves and other people in the past and recognise the difference between past and present in their own and others' lives.

English:

In English this term, the children will be start off by looking at the book 'The Colour Monster.' We will be writing short sentences to describe how their monsters are feeling. Continuing with our focus of feelings, we will then learn about and sequence the story 'Giraffes Can't Dance.' Additionally, there will be a range of activities to promote writing throughout our continuous provision.
