Maths:

This half term, our focus will be place value, addition and subtraction. We will carry out maths investigations linked to these areas and continue to develop our number fluency. **English:** We are starting this year by looking at the book *Ravi's Roar* which has a clear link to emotional regulation and growth mindset. Later this half term, we will write a recount, an explanation text and a story linked to our history learning.

History:

We will begin creating a timeline of what we already know from history topics covered in KS1 then add to it as we discover more about the Romans and Celts. We will find out about the every day lives of the Celts and Romans, including their culture, way of life, clothing etc. We will compare our findings and also learn about key aspects of Roman history including the Colosseum, Gladiators and Julius Caesar.

Computing:

This half term the children will be completing a unit of work on computing systems and networks. They will develop their understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs. We are really looking forward to using our new computing suite!

RE: This term, we will study Hindu writings, traditions and worship. In particular, we will explore what celebrating Diwali looks like at home and in the Hindu community and how to bring a sense of belonging to a Hindu child.

Wellbeing: We will be discussing and taking part in activities that make the children think about what makes a good learner, classmate and friend.
