Maths:

In maths, the children will be looking at place value. After they have consolidated their understanding of place value, they will move onto addition and subtraction. The children will be working with numbers up to 1000. There will be a heavy focus this year on

Science:


During Science this term, we will be looking at sound. They will identify how sounds are made through vibrations. The children will conduct a variety of experiments to enhance their understanding of sound.

History:

This term, we will be learning about the 'Terrifying Tudors'. We will be understanding where The Tudors period lies in relation to historical events and using time lines to help us.

We will also look to reconstruct life during the time studied using historical artefacts. As part of this, we will be visiting Hampton Court, which the children will love!

Within this topic, the children will be describing the similarities and differences between people, events and artefacts studied.



English:

During our English lessons, we will be recapping and developing their understanding and application of different types of narratives. The children will also be covering persuasive writing, where we will incorporate our topic, 'Terrifying Tudors'. We are kick starting the year with a powerful text called 'Mufaro's Beautiful Daughters'. We will be focusing on our handwriting this year, ensuring that children are joining.
