

**Maths:** In maths, we will begin to look at place value of numbers up to 20, introducing them to 2-digit numbers and what each number means. Using this information, we will add and subtract numbers up to 20.

## Year 1 Brilliant Britain



**English:** In English this term, the children will continue to look at different styles of writing. We will write a set of instructions on how to make the perfect sandwich. They will also retell a familiar story using actions to help them. Finally, we will look at writing Winter poems towards Christmas!

**Science:** In science the children will begin thinking about the seasons and weather changes throughout the year and being able to recognise how and why the weather changes with the seasons.

**Computing:** In computing this term, the children will be learning about online safety and using a painting app to create digital art..

**Music:** The children will continue to work with Mr Vinten in their music lessons this year. The children will continue to focus on rhythm and body percussion to create a beat as well as practicing for this year's Christmas Carol Concert.

**RE:** In RE this term, we will continue with Christianity.

**History:** In history, we will be comparing things from the past to things today with reference to London and, more locally, Banstead. What did London look like? What did people do? Why has it changed?

**Geography:** In Geography we will focus on the UK. We will find out where the UK is on a map and the four countries that make up the UK. We will also identify capital cities and other large cities in each of the four countries as well as the seas that surround it. We will also begin to accurately read maps to identify where we are. We will then focus on Banstead and the characteristics of that location. What does Banstead look like? What things does it have to make it a town? We will look at maps and explore our local area.

**Wellbeing Curriculum:** In our wellbeing lessons we will be celebrating our differences. Looking at where we belong and how we resolve conflicts.

**MFL:** The children will continue to learn Spanish this term and will move on to colours, animals and days of the week.

**PE:** During PE, Year 1 will learn about agility and practice this skill in a range of activities.

**DT:** In DT, the children will be learning how to handle food safely and exploring different types of fruit and eventually make their own fruit kebab.
