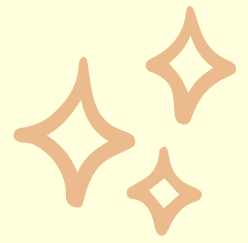


SEND NEWSLETTER

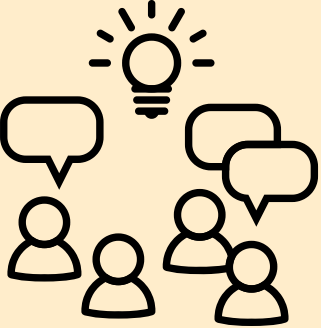

- Specific and **focused support** and representation in meetings with professionals, in mediations and at SENDIST Tribunals
