

Maths:

Looking at 2d and some 3d shapes, shape hunt in our environment- Road signs etc

Learning the names for some 2D and 3D shapes and using these to build different constructions,

Patterns made from shapes, repeating patterns, threading, magnetic shapes, shape sorters

Science:

Plants, flowers, gardening, seeds, measuring, ordering sizes and shapes, fruits and vegetables. Lifecycles

This half term we will be learning about Amelia Earhart – the first aviator to fly across the Atlantic!

Geography:

This half term we will be learning what a continent is and exploring the different continents. We will think about how these are different to each other – what do these places look like, what is the weather like and what do the schools look like?

Changes****Computing:**

We will learn how people use technology to communicate. We will talk about E-Safety and use the 'Digiduck' story to help us understand how to keep ourselves safe online.

RE:

Our topic this half-term is R.E is about festivals and we will be learning about festivals in various cultures, such as Chinese New Year which is celebrated in February. We will be learning about how these festivals are celebrated through food, special outfits and visits to places of worship.

PE:

In our PE lessons with Mr Thompson we will be practising games including Boccia and Boules. We will continue working on our physiotherapy targets each day within our class and enjoying working on our gross motor skills in soft play! We will also be practising moving in different ways using group games such as Dodgeball and games such as (transport themed) Simon Says.

English:

This term we will be learning to write letters and postcards. We will think about why these are important and useful within our lives. In addition, we will continue working on our phonics, including learning new sounds, recapping old sounds and learning our red words. We will continue to work on our fine motor skills throughout the day with lots of short activities that concentrate on developing the muscles in our hands. We will then use these skills to develop our writing and drawing.

Art/DT: We will be exploring 'colour' this half term. We will learn about the colour wheel and which primary colours combine to make other colours. We will experiment with adding black and white to colours to lighten or darken them. We will begin to think about how certain colours can make us feel or what they represent in art work. In D&T we will design and make a space rocket. We will consider what this is used for and who it is used by. We will learn how to choose and prepare materials and join them together.

Music:

In music this half term we will be considering the effect music can have on our emotions. We will give opinions on different music and how different music makes us feel. We will continue to learn about tempo (fast & slow) and dynamics (loud & quiet).
