

Maths:

Throughout maths, the children will be introduced to addition and subtraction. They will begin by using numbers to 10 and will then move on to addition and subtraction with numbers up to 20. The children will be learning about this through the support of pictures, manipulatives and number tracks.

English:

In English, the children will retell another story. They will have an opportunity to change an aspect of the story to make it more exciting! They will also be taught the features of a letter before writing their own letter about saving the environment.

Science:

The children will learn to distinguish between an object and the material it is made from. They will learn the names of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock and be able to identify them. They will be able to describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials. Finally, they will learn to compare and group together a variety of everyday materials based on their physical properties.

Year 1**Material Madness****Wellbeing Curriculum:**

The children will be learning and focusing on a number of different learning questions. These are:
 How can I resolve conflict?
 Where do I belong?
 How can my actions affect others?

Computing:

We will begin coding using robots. They will be learning how to use the buttons and knowing that certain buttons make the robot move in different directions. The children will be challenged to get from a start and end point using the least number of directions.

Music:

The children will continue to work with Mr Vinten on reading notes and following rhythm.

Geography:

The children will be doing a Climate and Environmental Study into recycling at home and school. We will create posters and ensure there is as little waste in our classrooms as possible.

RE:

In RE, the children will be learning about Christianity. Our focus question will be 'Was it easy for Jesus to show friendship?'

PE:

Our next topic is Dance. We will be exploring a range of styles of dancing.

Art/DT:

Our focus this term will be on colour and pattern. We will study Andy Goldsworthy and his work as an artist and nature sculptor.
