Math links: This half term we will be completing our unit of work on multiplication and division. We will begin with mental methods and then move on to formal written methods in multiplication and division. We will be using our times table knowledge for this, so please keep using your TTRS log in at home to practise. We will then move on to money.

English links:

For this term, we will be focusing our writing on: 'The Curious Case of the Missing Mammoth'. We will be starting the spring term by writing a non-chronological report on mammoths, where we will be visiting the Digiverse to carry out some research. After this, we will be writing our own newspaper reports on the missing mammoth.

Science: We will completing our work on magnets and moving on to identifying that animals including humans need the right type of nutrition. We will also be looking at humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.
