

Maths: This term we will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages.

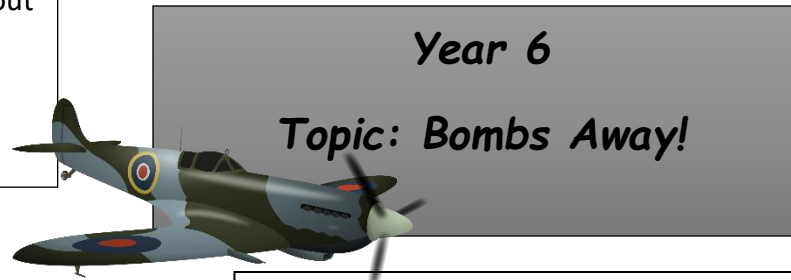
Science: We will be looking at inheritance and evolution. The children will learn about Charles Darwin's famous theory and explore how animals interact with their environments.

History: Our theme this term is based around World War II. We will be learning about The Blitz, propaganda, the countries involved, evacuation, shelters and much more! *We will also be looking at the experiences of GIs from black ethnicities while stationed in the UK.*

RE: *We will be exploring the question 'Is anything ever eternal?' and linking this to Christianity.*

Music: We will be focusing on music related to World War II. The children will experiment with recording their compositions in different ways.

English links: We will be using range of stimuli for creative writing: Persuasive speech about evacuation after the declaration of war and Cannes Lion Award-Winning advert of "Three Little Pigs" for newspaper with bias. We will also cover autobiographies in role. The children will continue to build on their knowledge of grammar and punctuation through a range of writing opportunities.
