Maths: The children will be reintroduced to fractions and will be looking at equivalent fractions, mixed number fractions and improper fractions. They will end Spring 2 by learning about decimals and recognise equivalents to tenths or hundredths.

English: Children will be writing their own newspaper reports based on the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb. They will be using role play to generate quotes from key people and using these within their report.

Science: This term we will be learning about electricity and understand how to create circuits using cells, cables, switches and light bulbs.

They will understand how a circuit needs to be complete in order to work.

Art/DT: We will be continuing to develop our understanding of colour and using their knowledge of the Egyptians, they will be creating Egyptian necklaces. In DT, children will have the opportunity to experiment with different materials to make an sarcophagus and canopic jar.

Computing: In our computing lessons, the children will be learning about data logging. This will include analysing data.

PE: The children will be focusing on Street Dance in Spring 1 and Pilates in Spring 2. Our Street dance unit will be linked to Egyptians.
