

Maths:

In maths we will be working on place value with numbers to 100! The children will also be introduced to new mathematical concepts including fractions, multiplication and division.

English:

In English this term, the children will continue to explore a range of writing styles. This will include writing their own instructions on how to extract a fossil, a recount and a retell of another familiar story.

History:

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In History, Year 1 will be learning about Mary Anning. We will cover what she did and why they she is such an important person from history. We will use this information to begin sequencing important events from the past in order of when they happened. We will also be comparing old and new things and describing the difference between things in the past and modern day.

After looking at how much of a change Mary Anning made, we will then study a change in our lifetime; the coronation of King Charles.
