Transition

How can you support your child's transition to nursery at home?

- * Talking about nursery
- * Driving/walking past the school
- * Promoting independence with daily routines:
(Dressing, eating, cutting food, toileting, putting on their coat, hand washing, blowing their nose)
- * Activities at home – painting, mark-making, construction, bikes and scooters, messy play!
- * Share a story – character voice, questioning, anticipating
- * Sharing and turn-taking
- * Socialising with other children

- * Friday 6th September

Settling in sessions

- * Monday 9th, Tuesday 10th, Wednesday 11th September

- * Full session am or pm Thursday 12th, Friday 13th September

* **Additional services + wraparound care**

- * Monday 23rd September

If your child is not ready to start each stage of the transition process, a more suitable time will be decided together with your key worker.

- * Home visit and gradual start
- * Short sessions

Packed Lunch

A healthy lunch box...

If your child is having a packed lunch please note the following:

- * Clearly named lunch box or bag
- * We are a **NUT FREE** school (No nuts, peanut butter, Nutella etc)
- * **No chocolate bars or sweets (Healthy treat alternative)**
- * Separate drink for lunch (as well as bottle of water for class)
(no fizzy or energy drinks, no drinks with high sugar content)
- * Children will bring all their rubbish home so that you can see what they have eaten during the day.
- * Please provide your child with the necessary cutlery needed for their lunch.



Please ensure your child has a healthy lunch with at least 1 piece of fruit or vegetables.

Online Booking System

SCOpay

- Used for payments towards nursery fees and school trips, or to book wraparound care
- Details given to parents in September with log in to create your child's SCOpay account
- **Payment of nursery fees**
 - Agreed nursery hours will automatically be uploaded each half term, with payment being required no later than 2 weeks from the start of each half term
 - 15 hours provision – no lunch is available unless your child is booked for an additional session during that day
 - 30 hours provision – lunch is automatically booked for all 5 days to ensure correct provision is in place across the year
 - Individual lunch arrangements must also be communicated on a *daily basis* to the Keyworker during drop off or in the contact book
- **Booking wraparound care sessions**
 - Online booking system – capped numbers to ensure adequate staff:child ratios
 - Account must be in credit to book sessions
 - Bookings must be made in advance (midnight on the night before) and any cancellations only refundable if 24 hours notice given
- **Payment for uniform/school trips**
 - School trips and events will be available on your child's account for you to make payment throughout the school year – you will be notified by email when payment is due

What Does Your Child Need?

- * Sensible, child friendly clothing and shoes
 - * Coat – **every day!**
 - * Wellington boots
 - * Book bag
 - * Spare clothes
 - * Bottle of water
 - * Sun hat
 - * Sun cream
- * **NO** flip-flops, backless sandals, crocs, ugg boots, strap tops, best clothes, laces

Wraparound Care

- * Wraparound care will begin on Monday 23rd September 24.
- * Every child is different and may not be ready straight away.
- * On site
- * Breakfast included
- * Evening tea
- * Wraparound care staff – familiar staff.

15hrs PM: 12:30pm-15:30pm

After school club: 15:30pm – 18:00pm

Absence

- * If your child is absent from school, you must ring the school office before 8.15am with the reason for their absence.
- * If your child has been sick, they must not be brought into school for 48 hours to prevent sickness spreading.
