Chipstead Valley Primary School, Nursery and ELP are committed to providing a fully accessible environment ensuring everyone values and includes all pupils, staff, parents and visitors. We are a fully inclusive provision and aim to meet the individual requirements of all staff, pupils, parents and carers.

Chipstead Valley Primary School continue to improve access to the physical environment, adding specialist equipment where necessary. This covers improvements and maintenance to the physical environment of the school and aids access to all areas of the curriculum.

This also includes all teaching and learning and the wider curriculum of the school such as participation in after-school clubs, leisure and cultural activities or school visits. It also covers the provision of specialist aids and equipment, which may assist these pupils in accessing the curriculum.

We aim to continue to develop the delivery of written information to pupils, staff, parents and visitors. The information should be made available in various required formats within a reasonable time frame.
